



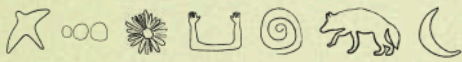

Welcome to the first collection of 2024, where garments become shields and fashion becomes a symbol of empowerment. A world where style and protection artfully entwine.



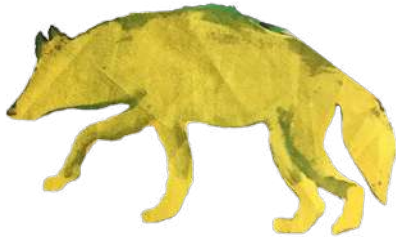
Amulets

A symbol of courage and strength. Sacred to Native Americans for their devotion for their family and pack.



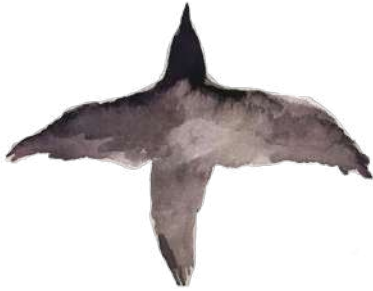
The Tree of Life

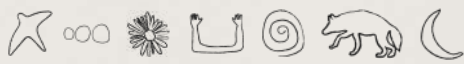
